1. Have you experienced doing the right thing and the result wasn't what you expected - no reward? bad things? something else? How does that affect your relationship with God when you do the right thing, and seem to get punished for

2. Read Esther 2:19-3:15

As followers of Jesus, we're called to do the right thing for God's glory (not our own). Did Mordecai do the right thing? If so, what was the reward? If not, what should he have done? Why would you say that?

Why can we be quick to seek earthly rewards and not Kingdom rewards? What steps can we take to have the proper priorities?

The Jews would have been tempted to be anxious and fearful in the wake of the decree that was made by Haman. What visible evidence of an invisible God do you see in these verses? As Christ followers today, what are we tempted to be anxious and fearful about? How can we give those over to the Lord? (Ref. 1 Peter 5:7)

- 3. Woven through the story of Esther is the fact that God is at work to preserve His people. Despite whatever may happen, whatever is plotted, God is able to leverage it - even the evil choices made to hurt us. How can and should we show compassion to people - even people who conspire against us? Why should we respond this way? (Ref. Galatians 6:10)
- 4. How can recalling God's faithfulness in the past inspire our trust and reliance on His faithfulness in the present and the future? Spend time in the "Digging Deeper" section for more on this!

God's Promises & Providence

This "Digging Deeper Study" is here for those of you who want to invest more, discover more, learn more and grow in your faith!

As we've looked at many times through the course of the Book of Esther - we see that God, through His providence and according to His promises, is able to preserve His people - no matter the circumstances. Take some time to prayerfully read Psalms 105 & 106. The Psalmist recalls God's deliverance for His people. Take it all in. Write down what you learn about God and His power to do what only He can do. May you end in the place the Psalmist does in Psalm 106:48!
