

1. If you could change one thing about yourself, what would it be? How could God accomplish His plan through you without changing anything?

2. Read **Exodus 3:1-10**.

Why did God use a lot of shepherds? What are the skills and virtues of a competent shepherd that are also valuable in a leader of persons? How do you see God preparing Moses for this new season through the season before?

The LORD called out to Moses to come closer. This calling out and response is a regular occurrence through the Scriptures. Can you think of other times God called someone out for relationship and service? How have you been called out by God? (Hint: if you're a Christ follower, you've been called out and responded to the call).


God sees, hears and acts on behalf of His people. Where do you see God's motive in these verses? God's purpose? God's plan? Ultimately, God's plan was a man, a savior, a redeemer, a leader who was being trained and raised up: Moses. Do you think that Moses and God were on the same page? Discuss a time when you and God were not on the same page in what He wanted you to do, and what you wanted to do.

3. Read **Exodus 3:11-4:17**.

God was commissioning Moses, calling him into service for God's people. Take time to discuss Moses' objections and the LORD's response. How does every answer find itself in the LORD. How can we be like Moses? What is God speaking into your life about your situation?

4. The answer to everything is that God will be with you. How does that answer our problems, insecurities, struggles and... everything? What comfort and power does that give you in walking out God's call on your life? How does God's presence bring power? How have you experienced this?

5. What is God calling you into, that you need to stop trying harder and just surrender more?
