

1. Looking back, when was God teaching you the most in your life's journey? At the time, did it seem like you were being delayed? Betrayed? How can your past experience help you as you face more difficulties, delays and seemingly betrayals?

2. Read **Exodus 13:17-22**.

List specific instances where you see God's power and direction.

A often repeated phrase so far in Exodus is Pharaoh having a "hard heart." What do you think this means? How did this happen? Did God give Pharaoh a hard heart, or did He orchestrate circumstances (knowing the heart of Pharaoh) that would bring this about?

If we're not careful, this can happen to us. Describe how this might happen and what it might look like in our lives. How do we combat that?

3. Read Exodus **14:10-14**.

The far-superior, over-matched army of Pharaoh was closing in the Israelites. On one side was this powerful army, on the other was the Red Sea. They had clearly been led by the LORD to this spot, but now things look hopeless. How did they respond to the LORD and to Moses? How would you have responded?


What was Moses response? What role did the people play in their salvation? What role did the LORD play in their salvation?

How is this the exact picture of salvation for us today? (Ref. Ephesians 2:1-9, 2 Corinthians 5:21, Titus 3:5)

4. Read **Exodus 14:15-31**.

How do you see that God is able to make a way where there is no way? What significant things do you see that demonstrate God's power? How is this a demonstration of God's power, placing Him above ANY "god"? How, also, is that a demonstration of God's judgement and God's mercy all at the same time?

5. What principles can you apply to your life from these verses?
