

1. If you were going to share the Gospel with someone, how would you begin that message? Would you start by focusing on the love of God? Or something else? Why?

2. Read **Romans 1:18-32**

When most would begin the message of the Gospel with God's love for the person, where does Paul begin? Why do you think that's the case?

After reading this passage, is it possible to people to truly not know about God? Why would you say that? How have you experienced that reality in your own life? Is this revelation of Who God is able to save you or is there some other purpose (check out **verse 20**).

What do you think God will do with "good people" or "people who have never heard the Gospel" - will they be with God for eternity? Why do you believe that?


Discuss the significance of the "dual exchange" that is described in verses 23 & 25, and the significance of the "divine giving over" described in verses 24, 26 & 28. How are the two connected?

What would Paul say are the results of rejecting God and His truth? How do you see the battle between "God's design" and "People's desires" playing out in the passage and in our own world?

3. From a cultural perspective, when it comes to sexual sin, we have made homosexuality the ultimate sin, while ignoring other sexual sins. What significance does **1 Corinthians 6:9-11** play in helping to have a proper understanding?

4. At the end of this chapter, Paul is expressing that ultimately, in and of yourself, you're not a good person. How can that, at the same time, feel off-putting but be the exact thing we all need to hear, believe and understand in order to come to saving faith in Jesus?

5. How have you responded to the love, grace and mercy of the Lord expressed in the Gospel?
