


- 1. As Christ followers, we are called to walk in obedience to what God says, what makes it difficult to walk in obedience to God? What excuses do we make in the hopes of justifying continuing to walk in sin?
- 2. What's your reaction to: The master you habitually obey is evidence of who you truly follow. What implications do Jesus' words in John 8:34 have on this statement and your life?

3. Read Romans 6:15-23

- a. Paul contrasts being a slave to sin and a slave to God (obedience). How would you differentiate the two? What does it look like to serve each? How are we unable to serve God, apart from a relationship with God? Why would we continue to serve sin as a follower of Christ?
- b. Take time to look at the realities of who are in Christ check out the insert in the bulletin or go here: bit.ly/3Q9zLqL Which one(s) do you need to dwell on this week? Which one(s) do you have a difficult time believing, realizing, knowing?
- c. When Paul mentions sanctification, what is he referring to? How is the definition of sanctification "to put something to it's intended purpose" enhance your understanding of who you were created to be and how Jesus helps bring that about?
- d. What is your understanding of sanctification being both a point and a process bring understanding, hope and encouragement? Where are you in the process of sanctification / the reproducible process (ref. Real-life discipleship)? What's your next step?
- e. How is verse 23 more of a verse focused on sanctification than it is a verse for evangelism?
- 4. In Chapter 6 Paul instructs believers to day "no" to sin and "yes" to God. Why are both decisions important?
- 5. As a result of what you've learned today, what is God calling you to do? How will you walk in that today? This week? Your life on-going?
