

ELDER-LED CHURCH

This year, we are voting on making the transition to an Elder-led model of leadership at Northampton. This shift will serve the church well now and into the future as we walk in a healthy, Biblical model of church structure.

Northampton began this discussion many years ago, and in 2018, after realizing that we cannot have an Elder-led church without Elders, we began efforts to identify and train up men to be Elders. It has been a huge commitment to learn, study, complete readings, quizzes, tests and an in-person interview in the process of being accredited, and the following three men, our first ever Elder candidates, were presented to the Congregation:

The pathway forward will be to continue to identify, train and accredit future Elders to lead Northampton into the future.

We are also working on a Deacon Accreditation that will identify, equip, train and raise up men and women to fulfill the role of Deacon. Elders lead ministry, Deacons (Directors) facilitate ministry, and Partners (and attenders) do ministry at Northampton. In that environment, our aim is to invest, equip, empower and raise up leaders to help God's church to grow in health and making disciples as we all work together for God's Kingdom.
