

1. How have you struggled in your life trusting God (His Words and His promises) in the times when He feels far away, or doesn't feel like He's listening to you?

2. Read **Romans 9:1-29**

How does Paul feel about his unbelieving brothers and sisters (his fellow Jews)? How should that guide our hearts and attitudes toward people in our lives who don't know Jesus?

How might it look like that God's promises have failed in light of the blessings and promises the Jews have received, but have not responded to the Gospel?

When Paul says that "not all descended from Israel are Israel" what does he mean? How does this speak to physical verses spiritual birth?

Take time to discuss the points that Paul makes and how they defend the proposition that God's Word has not failed:


God never promised salvation to all (6b-13)

Salvation has always been a free gift of God's electing love (14-23)

The gift of salvation is a free gift to all (24-29)

3. How has your understanding of God's election impacted what you have believed to this point? How has your perspective been changed? How has it been strengthened? What impact does election have on your faith?

4. What's your next step? Have you responded to the Gospel? If not, why not? If you have, how are you walking in dependence upon the Lord toward obedience and passionately sharing the Gospel with the world?
