2. Read **Romans 13:8-10**

3. Read **Luke 10:25-29**

The "lawyer" was really an expert in the religious law. What was his motivation in approaching Jesus? How do people approach Jesus like this today?


4. Read **Luke 10:29-37**

In response to this man, Jesus tells a parable. How were the expectations of the characters turned upside down? Meaning: Who would be expected to be the "hero" of the story? Why? Who actually was? Why is this significant?
