1. When was the last time you felt like you had a clear sense of purpose in your life? What was it, and how did it affect the way you lived day to day?

2. Read **Romans 15:14-33**.

Paul was confident in the Roman believers but still reminded them of their mission to share the gospel. In what areas of your life do you feel like you've been given clarity about your purpose? Are there areas where you feel unsure or unclear about your purpose?

Think about your daily routine. How does having a clear mission impact your priorities and decisions? What's one thing you could do this week to focus more on living with clarity in your purpose?

Paul's plans were often interrupted by his mission to serve others. How do you typically react when your plans are interrupted? Can you think of a time when an unexpected interruption turned into an opportunity for something good or meaningful?

Are there any "interruptions" or detours that you think God may be using to accomplish something in your life or the lives of others? What could it look like to embrace these interruptions as part of God's plan?

Paul asks the believers in Rome to join him in prayer, showing his dependence on the community. Who do you depend on for support, prayer, or encouragement in your life? How does that support help you stay on mission? How can you be more intentional about leaning on and contributing to your community of faith?

Think about your role in this LIFE group and at Northampton. What's one way you can deepen your commitment to this community? How can you encourage others to live with purpose?

3. Reflect on this week's sermon takeaway: "A purpose-driven life is a life that's clear on mission, open to interruptions, and committed to community."

Which of these three areas (clarity of mission, openness to interruptions, or commitment to community) do you feel like God is calling you to focus on this week?

What's one small step you can take in that area?
