

1. When you read through **Romans 16**, what stands out to you about the people Paul mentions? Did any particular name or description surprise you? Why?

2. One thing that was mentioned on Sunday was the “whitespaces” in Scripture. What is meant by that? Why is it significant to see what’s being “said” in the whitespaces? Why must we be careful and discerning when looking at the whitespaces?

3. Read **Romans 16**.

Reading in the whitespaces, what do you see about Paul’s heart for the Lord, for God’s people, for the Kingdom of God?

How do you see the things that really matter in this passage? How do you see the fact that “relationships matter” is communicated? How do you see “the Gospel” matters? What about “unity matters?”

Digging in more...

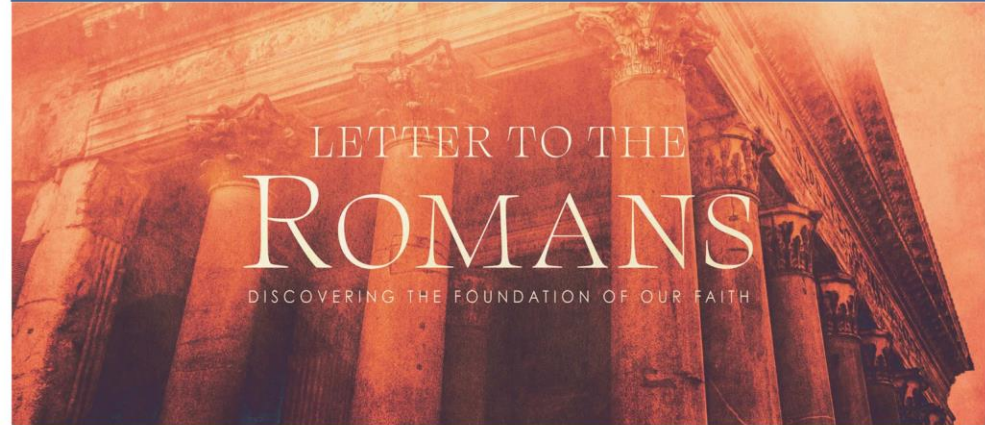
Who are the “Priscillas and Aquilas” in your life—people who have supported or encouraged you in your faith journey? How have they impacted you?
