

1. What have you believed tithing to be? How have you felt about tithing in your life as a Christ follower? How has it been more of a “church tax” than it has been about worshipping the Lord? What do you do when what you have believed and been taught doesn’t necessarily align with what Scripture says?

2. Read: **2 Corinthians 9:6-7**

What principles and guidelines do you learn from these two verses? How do these address both the heart and the hands of your life?

How is this passage (and the other passages we looked at Sunday) help you to see that Tithing was always a tax and we’re called to something different today?

3. Read: **Psalms 51:16-17, Matthew 6:21,24 & 22:37-40**

What do you learn from these verses about the importance of your heart as a Christ follower? What is God most concerned about? Why?

How should that affect the way you live?

4. As you think about what it means to live generously, how would our church, your family, your job, other areas look different if you embraced the idea that “all that I have and all that I am belongs to God”? How would it affect the decisions you make? How would it affect everything?

5. What have you learned about tithing and giving that is new or different than you have heard / learned before? How will what you have learned change the way that you think and live moving forward?
