1. Can you remember a time when you felt like an outsider or overlooked? How did that experience impact you?

2. Read Matthew 9:9-13

Why do you think Jesus chose Matthew, a tax collector, as one of His disciples? How does Jesus' response to the Pharisees challenge the way we view "insiders" and "outsiders" in our own lives?

Who are the "tax collectors and sinners" in our world today? How can we intentionally reach out to them?

3. Read Matthew 8:1-3

Why is it significant that Jesus touched the leper before healing him? What does this reveal about Jesus' heart for the outcasts?

Who might feel "untouchable" in our community, and how can we show them love and acceptance?

4. Read Matthew 15:21-28

What stands out to you about the Canaanite woman's faith? How does Jesus' interaction with her expand our understanding of who belongs in God's kingdom? Have you ever been surprised by someone's faith, especially someone you didn't expect?

- 5. Is there a part of your past or present that makes you feel like an outcast? How does what you learned in Matthew change your perspective on how Jesus sees you?
- 6. Are there people or groups you tend to overlook or avoid? Why is that, and how might Jesus be challenging you to see them differently? Who is one person in your life that needs to be seen, welcomed, or loved? What's one practical step you can take this week to reach out to them?
- 7. How can our LIFE group and our church become more welcoming to those who feel like outsiders?
