

1. Read Matthew 28:1-10.

What stands out to you in this resurrection account that you hadn't noticed before?

The angel says, "He is not here; He has risen, just as He said." Why do you think Jesus' followers didn't expect Him to rise, even though He said He would?

The angel also says, "Come and see... go and tell." Which of those is more natural for you—and which is more difficult? Why?

In verse 8, it says the women were "afraid yet filled with joy." How can faith and fear coexist in moments of obedience?

2. The resurrection is the defining moment of history. How has the resurrection shaped your personal story?

Can you name a "defining moment" in your spiritual life so far?

- 3. When in your life have you had to "walk in the dark," like the women did that morning—moving forward even when you couldn't see clearly?
- 4. What "stone" has Jesus rolled away in your life—something that once felt like a dead end, but became a doorway to new life?
- 5. If this Easter is meant to be a defining moment for you, how do you want to respond?
