Worship 129 2023-2024 = 117 2022-2023 = 103




Decisions

Last year, NBStudents directed its focus at teaching students what it means to know God and to accept Christ as Lord. This year, having that foundation laid, the focus has been able to shift to teaching students how to live their lives while placing Christ at the center of everything. One of the first directions we took the students was to show them their need for community; to establish strong relationships with other Christ followers and the need to find mentors in their lives. Because of this, we have seen students live out their faith amongst their friends and let Christ dictate their relationships. We've also had several students come forward and seek out mentorship. These students are meeting with our leaders to work out how to live in Christ honoring ways and see practical applications of how to apply the Bible to their lives.

The second direction we took the students was to help them build trust in their community. We have brought small groups into our weekly programming and life groups into our routine that have seen students learn to trust those around them enough to begin opening up about the struggles in their lives. This newly established trust has seen a student-run bible study form on its own that meets weekly. This trust has been made possible by getting students to spend time together while doing fun things together. This was made possible by your investment into our ministry. The events and outings funded by you have given our leaders the opportunities to spend time with students and show them that a life of obedience to Christ is worth it.

Your contributions have allowed us to share many meals together, meals where students can have real food with real people. You've funded students going real life camping as well as a winter retreat where they spent time worshipping the Lord and experiencing His goodness. You funded "Banana-Rama" where students ran around our auditorium with over 100 bananas and brought their friends who got to hear the gospel for the first time. Your contributions allow us to provide a space for students they love coming to, while giving our leaders opportunities to share Christ with them and help them to follow Him. Without your aid, we would just be a church basement. God would still work, but we would have to work so much harder in the lives of our students.

Thank you for being a part of this work with us. Pray for us this next year as NBStudents continues to deepen our students' relationship with Christ. Pray for our leaders, that they would not grow weary of the work. And pray for me, that I will see Christ at the center of all that this ministry does and to not get caught up in creating something purely attractive.
