3. Read **Colossians 1:15–17**.
What do these verses teach us about Jesus' relationship to creation?
4. Paul says, "in him all things hold together" (**v. 17**). What does that mean in practical terms for our world and our lives?
5. Read **verses 18–20**. What does it mean for Jesus to be the "head of the body, the church"? How should this shape the way we see church life? What other passages speak to this that can deepen your understanding of this concept?
6. According to **verses 21–23**, what has Christ done for us personally? How does Paul describe who we were before Christ and who we are now in Him? (Ref. **Ephesians 2**)
7. Where in your life are you tempted to live as if you are in charge instead of Christ?
8. What would it look like for you to live out the reality that Jesus is already supreme in your relationships, work, or family?
9. **Verse 23** calls us to "continue in your faith, established and firm." What helps you stay rooted in Christ when life feels unstable?
10. Who in your life needs to see or hear that Jesus is Lord of all? How can you show or share that truth this week?
