BEYOND SUNDAY

Questions for reflection, conversation, and application

CONNECTING TOGETHER

1. Have you ever struggled with assurance of your salvation? What tends to trigger those doubts?

CONNECTING TO THE PASSAGE

Read **John 10:27-30**

What does Jesus say is true about His sheep in **verses 27-28**? What does each statement reveal about our relationship with Him?

Jesus says, "I give them eternal life, and they will never perish." What confidence should those words give someone who has genuinely trusted Christ?

Jesus twice says that no one can "snatch" His sheep away. Where does the security of the sheep seem to rest in this passage?

Read **Hebrews 10:12-14**. How does Christ's completed sacrifice help us understand the statement, "Our sin cannot undo what the cross accomplished"?

Read **Romans 8:31-39**. What threats to our security does Paul name? What is his conclusion about our relationship with God through Christ?

John 10:27 says Jesus' sheep "follow me." How can a changed life provide evidence of genuine salvation without becoming the basis of our salvation?

CONNECTING TO APPLICATION

1. Where do you tend to look for assurance: your feelings, your performance, or the promises of Jesus? How should knowing that Jesus holds you securely change the way you respond when you sin or fail?

2. How can assurance in Christ produce greater obedience and love rather than spiritual complacency?
