Connecting Together

What is one good thing people can easily begin trusting in besides Jesus? Why do you think we have such a hard time believing Jesus is enough?

Connecting to the Passage

Read **Galatians 1:1-10**

What does Paul emphasize about what Jesus has done for us? Why do you think Paul begins with grace and peace?

In **verses 6-7**, What surprised Paul about the Galatians? What are some ways people add requirements to the gospel today?

Why does Paul respond so strongly in **verses 8-9** to anyone changing the gospel?

According to **verse 10**, how can the desire for people's approval affect our faithfulness to Jesus?

Connecting to Application
